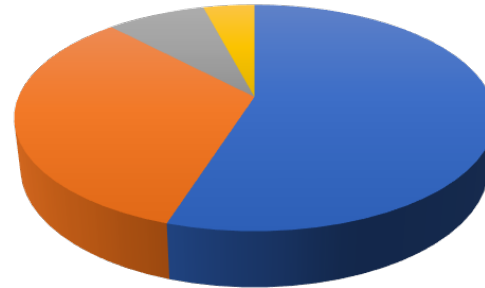
LEARN HOW TO MAKE ROSARIES

1000 Rosaries are made for St. Mary's Parish – for funerals, weddings, holidays, baptisms.

600 Rosaries are made for the Peruvian children. For some, it is the only gift they receive at Christmas time.

145 Rosaries are made for the First Holy Communicants.

115 Rosaries are made for Confirmation.
