**I THIRST** Spiritual Companionship Program (ITSC) is a two-day training with three follow-up webinars. This free two-day seminar offers training on how to be an effective **I THIRST** Spiritual Companion (ITSC) for those suffering from addictions and their families. An ITSC is someone who offers spiritual consolation and recovery resource information—he or she is a cross between a spiritual director and a recovery coach. These individuals will be the "boots on the ground" in parishes, offering specialized care and consolation to this vulnerable and marginalized population. The training will be followed by three monthly mentoring webinars in which participants will share their experiences with the community. This training is open to all parishioners, clergy and parish/school employees who are 21+ in the Archdiocese of Boston. No prior addiction recovery experience is needed. Are you being called to help?
